Daily Itinerary

1

Day 1: Nairobi to Tsavo East

Depart Nairobi and drive south-east on the Mombasa highway — the iconic "lunatic express" railway passes alongside. Enter Tsavo East at Voi Gate. Afternoon game drive: look for Tsavo's famous red-dusted elephant herds, lion prides and the enormous Tsavo ecosystem's diverse plains wildlife. Check in to your riverside lodge.

Stay: Tsavo East lodge · **Meals:** Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Tsavo East — Galana River & Lugard Falls

Full day exploring Tsavo East. Morning drive along the Galana River — a lifeline for wildlife in this semi-arid wilderness. Lugard Falls: dramatic rapids carved through ancient rock where crocodiles bask on the banks. Afternoon drive across the Yatta Plateau — the world's longest lava flow — and through vast elephant territory.

Stay: Tsavo East lodge · **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3: Cross to Tsavo West — Mzima Springs

Morning drive through the Chyulu Hills corridor between Tsavo East and Tsavo West. Arrive at Mzima Springs — crystal-clear volcanic springs where hippos submerge and shoals of barbel fish glide past. An underwater viewing chamber gives a unique hippo perspective. Afternoon game drive in Tsavo West — known for black rhino sightings.

Stay: Tsavo West lodge · **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Shetani Lava Flow & Chaimu Crater

Morning walk on the ancient Shetani lava flow — a 200-year-old black basalt landscape stretching to the horizon. Climb Chaimu volcanic crater for panoramic views. Afternoon game drive through lush corridors where elephants, buffalo and giraffe feed among towering euphorbia trees.

Stay: Tsavo West lodge · **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: Final Drive & Return to Nairobi

Final morning game drive with hopes of a leopard sighting in the rocky outcrops. After breakfast, pack up and begin the return journey to Nairobi, arriving by evening.
